

#### Your Experience

Get picked up from your hotel and head towards your first destination - Batuan Temple. Upholding the Hindu fundamental concept of Tri Murti, the temple offers various reliefs depicting mythical Balinese figures. The main draws here are the well-preserved sandstone bas motifs and the uniqueness of the roof which comes from its quality of being made entirely of chromatic black palm tree fiber. After this, you will witness one of Bali's best-kept secrets - Tibumana Waterfalls, a secluded paradise where 'twin' waterfalls roar mighty against the wind. Next, visit a coffee plantation and learn how to make the traditional Balinese brew, before heading to Tegalalang Rice Fields. Perhaps the most iconic of all, this valley of rice paddies offers scenic lookouts over verdant landscapes.



Make way to the south of Mexico City for a scenic tour of the enchanting neighborhoods of Xochimilco and Coyoacán.



#### Your Experience

Add some color to your day of sightseeing with a visit to Xochimilco and Coyoacan. Meet your tour group and head toward your first destination - Coyoacán or 'the place of coyotes,' where Frida Kahlo spent most of her life. Snake along tree-lined blocks, enjoy the sights and sounds of exotic squares and wander down cobblestoned alleys lined with cafés, antique shops, and craft stalls. Coyoacán apart from being a Bohemian and artistic draw is known for one other thing - the National University of Mexico (UNAM), which boasts of eccentric murals referencing Mexican heritage, culture, history, and primordial origins. Spend time admiring the works of famous artists who were involved in the Mexican Muralist Movement.

Next, you will head to the wondrous, watery, and flower-strewn oasis of Xochimilco, one of Frida Kahlo's favorite places. This gritty neighborhood serves as the last remnants of the Aztec's intricate canal and farming system called chinampas. Go punting along the ancient waterways on a colorful trajinera (flat-bottomed boat), and surround yourself with a roving world of mariachi and marimba music.




If you've always been fascinated by the work of nature, then a visit to Yehliu Geopark will simply thrill all your senses.




### Your Experience

Located on the remote north coast of Taiwan, Yehliu Geopark is characterized by its quirky geological formations that resemble various objects. Although Yehliu is just over two hours from Taiwan, it's like stepping into a whole new world. The eroding seascape, stony shorelines, and the picturesque cape is all too reinvigorating. It is the constant drumming of the ocean against the shores, erosion from the wind and exposure to the atmosphere that resulted in the land being carved into a series of rocky formations. The most famous of these at Yehliu is the Queen's Head, but there are many others, such as the Fairy's Shoe, Ice-cream Cone, and the Sea Candles. The entire park is walkable within 2 hours so you can definitely fit in other activities throughout the day. Despite its remote location, the park is well-equipped from free Wi-Fi to bicycle stations, locker rooms and more.






